1. Registration

- **Entry period** 2012 Jan 30 (Mon) – Feb 10 (Fri) (according to stamp chop).
- **Method** **By post only.** Download application form from school homepage www.kis.edu.hk, click “TOPIK” icon. Complete the application form (**1 photo attached**) and return to Korean International School. On the envelope mark “TOPIK” with \$350 cheque **must** be enclosed. (**no return envelope needed**)
- **Test fee** HK\$350 cheque or bank draft payable to “Korean International School”, please write name at the back.

2. **Test date** April 15, 2012 (Sunday)

3. **Test center** Korean International School, 55 Lei King Road, Sai Wan Ho, Hong Kong

4. **Time** **Beginner & Advanced : 8.30am Intermediate : 1.30pm**

(Candidates must be seated 20minutes before test starts. It is advised to be at school 30 minutes prior to the test.)

Ans: Yes, 2 separate forms are needed. Application fee can be paid in one \$700 cheque. Please write candidate name on the back of the cheque.

Q 4. Any pass paper available?

Ans: Pass paper is available at TOPIK official website www.topik.go.kr.

Q 5. How do I know my application is being processed and when will I receive the identification slip?

Ans: All candidates will receive confirmation through email after being registered within few days. Identification slip and receipt will be post in mid-March.

Criteria for determining successful applicant :

One cannot obtain a failing score in **any** of the sections under evaluation (Vocabulary & Grammar, Writing, Listening or Reading). Candidate whose average score from all sections test meets the passing score shall be deemed to have earned the corresponding grade level in his/her test level.

<Example> An applicant applied for “Basic” level and received a score of 82 points in Vocabulary & Grammar, 48 in Writing, 76 in Listening and 80 in Reading. What would be the applicant’s score?

<Answer> The applicant would obtain Grade 1.

The average score for the entire test was 71.5 (total 286/ 4 sections), which was above the passing score for Grade 2. Although 3 parts were in high marks, the score in Writing was below 50 (the cutoff point for Grade 2). Therefore, this applicant received Grade 1 not Grade 2.

4. When taking test :

<On test day>






1. All candidates must present valid TOPIK Identification Slip and personal identification (HKID card/passport) in order to take the test.
2. Bring stationary, such as pens, pencils, erasers and correction tape.
3. If only take one session of the test, candidate will be disqualified.

<Before each session>

4. Candidates must be seated at classroom 20 minutes before each session starts.
5. Place identification slip at the upper left hand corner of the desk.
6. Each candidate will receive a computer sign-pen.

<When filling out answers for multiple choice questions>

7. Candidate can mark answers on question paper if needed.
8. Answers must be marked on answer paper by the provided sign-pen. No points will be given marked by other pens.
9. Correction tape (not fluid) can be used for correction. No points will be given if more than one answers.
10. Mark answer carefully, example:

<When filling out answer for statement and composition>

11. Answers to the subjective questions and descriptive answers in Writing part must be written in the respective column on the front page of answer sheet where composition at the back.
12. Pen or pencil may be used to answer the writing section.
13. For answers made with a pen, use correction tape or draw two lines through an answer to make a correction.

<After each session>

13. Place the answer sheet on the right hand side of desk and the examination paper on the left.
14. Any candidate keep filling out answers after the test time has ended will have his/her test invalidated.
15. Candidate may only leave the classroom after the finish bell rings at each session.

5. Unauthorized behavior :

Anyone found to have engaged in any kind unauthorized behavior will be immediately expelled from the test room and have his/her test invalidated. Types of unauthorized behavior include:

1. Using of any kind of wireless communication device (mobile phone, MP3 player, beepers, etc) during the test.
2. Taking the test for another person.
3. Showing answer sheet to another test taker or copying answers from another test taker during the test.
4. Talking with, exchanging an object(s) with, or exchanging signals with another test taker during the test.
5. Not following the instructions of the superintendent.

6. From the year 2012 on, validity period of the result will be 2 years (from issue date of the result).

7. Cancellation :

1. If typhoon signal No.8 or above remains hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force at 7am on the test day, test in the morning will be canceled.
2. If typhoon signal No.8 or above remains hoisted or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force at noon on the test day, test in the afternoon will be canceled.
3. Other than the above mentioned weather situation, all tests will be remained proceeding. If test is canceled due to weather condition, application fee will be fully refunded.
