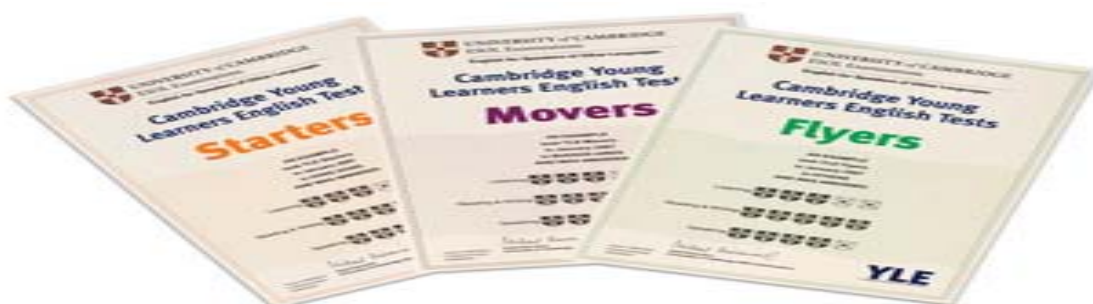


After school ESL

The school has a vibrant after school ESL programme which runs on Mondays and Thursdays between 3:10pm and 4:10pm. These after school English tutorials are taught by KIS teachers, and there is a choice of whether to enrol for a term or the whole school year. A letter regarding these classes is given to parents in mid-September, informing them about the enrolment procedure and fee (\$150 per lesson), the purchasing of the course book and the dates when the classes will be held.

We provide instruction for every general English course offered by Cambridge ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages). These courses are Starters, Movers and Flyers for primary along with KET and PET for secondary. Starters is the first level, aimed at young children with very basic skills. As children develop and work their way up to the Flyers certificate, they reach a level that will enable them to aim for the Key English Test (KET) or the Preliminary English Test (PET) in the General English range of certificates, qualifications which will be of value for further study or in the workplace. Information concerning the taking of these tests is given to parents at the start of April.



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
