

Read to Give
Keeping sick children close to their families



Dear parents,

Korean International School is presenting the “READ FOR RONALD” programme to our students. Through this programme, students are encouraged develop a habit of regular reading while raising funds to care for sick children and their families in Hong Kong. Students set targets for reading for the next few weeks and find sponsors to support their reading challenge through promising to donate a certain amount of dollars for each book (R-Y3) or for each 10 minutes (Y4-6) that the student reads. Students start reading books of their choice and at the end of the period collects the donations from the sponsors. The proceeds go to funding the operations of the Ronald McDonald House.

Ronald McDonald House is a charity that provides short-term accommodation for families with seriously ill children who received medical treatment in the nearby hospital. It was established in 1996 in Shatin, Hong Kong, and was Asia’s first chapter. The House is equipped with 23 family rooms, including 1 isolation suite specially conceived for bone marrow transplant patients; a common kitchen; a living room and a dining room; a library; a computer room; and indoor as well as outdoor play areas. To date, Ronald McDonald House has helped and provided family-care service to more than 5,300 children and families who have recuperated at the House. Children who registered in the Ronald McDonald House are mainly suffering from serious-illnesses such as cancer, trauma, burns and bone marrow transplant.

The programme starts TODAY! Students should find sponsors during Chinese New Year and put them in the Sponsor Form (Y4-6), attached, then hand the form to their class teachers on February 11. Students should also start to read from now until April 19. The minutes will be tallied up using the KIS Reading Passport for Y4-6. Students will then have from April 19-26 to collect the donations and pass them to their class teacher on April 26.

The teachers of Korean International School look forward to our students participating in this fantastic programme of reading and charity. Thank you very much for your cooperation.
